- b. First Vice: Submitted application for the flyover during Memorial Day
- c. Adjutant: Last meeting the idea was introduced to combine Boys and Girls State. After researching the issue, it was found that 6 of 7 states holding "combined" meetings held them during the same week at the same place, but did not otherwise combine the two (except with possible convocations). Massachusetts combined Boys and Girls state for some classroom work, to better utilize experts in law and economics who had been available to Boys but not Girls State. Otherwise the two were separate. Idea of a resolution combining the two in Ohio is thus withdrawn from consideration, pending more interest from parents/teens and/or posts.
- d. <u>Chaplin</u>: A supposed photo from Canfield high school year book from 1977 yearbook showing seniors in KKK outfits was posted to an alumni social media website, causing a number of complaints, phone calls, etc. The school superintendent plans to address this. Canfield has been accused of a racist, and a discussion ensued concerning this issue.
